Per the IUPAT Constitution, the IUPAT Pension, starting 1/1/22 will increase 5% of the negotiated annual increase (Apprentices shall be based on their corresponding percentage of the Journeymen contributions

MINIMUM WAGE STANDARDS (MWS) -

The higher rate shall prevail in counties and cities where the minimum wage is higher than the wage listed on this schedule.

(The wage of \$21.45 is based on 130% of the 2024 California Minimum Wage. if the minimum wage increases after this publication, the employer is required to calculate the new wage at 130% above the current rate.
